UBMD Pediatrics is seeking two genetic counselors to join our Division of Genetics. We provide a wide range of genetic services to both children and adults in Western New York. Our counselors provide services at our outpatient genetics clinics, multidisciplinary clinics, and also help with inpatient genetic testing. We currently have two clinical geneticists (one dysmorphologist and one metabolic geneticist), a genetics nurse practitioner and a metabolic dietician. This position will offer some flexibility to work from home.

Responsibilities:

- Provide counseling, genetic testing, and coordination of care for individuals and/or families with or at risk of genetic disorders
- Collect appropriate clinical and family history information
- Analyze and interpret laboratory results
- Disclose genetic test results/educate patients, families and referring physicians
- Complete clinic notes in the electronic medical record
- Work with medical students and residents who rotate through the division
- Help teach medical genetics to first year medical students, if interested
- Act as a professional/community resource

Qualifications:

- M.S. in Genetic Counseling from an accredited genetic counseling program
- Board certified or board eligible by the American Board of Genetic Counselors (ABGC) or the American Board of Medical Genetics (ABMG)
- Effective written and oral communication skills
