CARE TEAM

Your Adolescent Medicine care team will include attending physicians and a nutritionist along with the clinical staff (i.e. nurses, medical assistants).

Our diverse staff provides specialized and multi-disciplinary services focused on the health and psychosocial needs of adolescents and young adults ages 12-30 years.

SPECIALIZED CARE

- Evaluation and treatment of eating disorders including obesity
- Reproductive health care
- Testing and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases
- Evaluation, treatment and referral for alcohol and substance abuse
- Evaluation and treatment of gynecological problems
- Evaluation, 2nd opinions and treatment for complex multi-factorial/chronic conditions
- Follow-up of post-sexual assault patients and management of post-exposure prophylaxis medications
- Care for adolescents with chronic disease
- Routine HIV testing and risk reduction counseling and access to an HIV treatment specialized program
- Medical management and care coordination of mental health conditions
- Immunizations
- Functional abdominal pain
- Gender dysphoria
